- The Joint Guidelines on Changes Orders, Extra Work Orders, etc. as provided under the pertinent provisions of the RA 9184 and Department Order No. 2014 of 2004, are hereby incorporated as part of this CONTRACT;
- 9. Within a period of One Hundred Twenty (120) Calendar Days after the completion and final acceptance of this PROJECT, the CONTRACTOR shall remain liable for any damage/s or defect/s discovered of the works due to faulty construction methods or the use of materials of inferior quality or violation of the terms and conditions of this CONTRACT;
- 10. The CONTRACTOR shall be held responsible for any structural defects and/or failure of the completed projects within fifteen (15) years for permanent structures after Final Acceptance except those occasioned by force majeure and those caused by the other parties; the EMPLOYER/OWNER shall use perpetual disqualification to the CONTRACTOR from participating in any public bidding, if fails to comply with the Warranty Provisions under Section 62 of RA 9184;
- 11. The CONTRACTOR shall pay taxes in full and on time and that failure to do so will entitle the Government to suspend payment for the contract;
- 12. The CONTRACTOR shall likewise regularly present within duration of the contract, a tax clearance from the BIR as well as a copy of its income and business tax returns duly stamped received by the BIR and duly validated with the tax payments made thereon;
- 13. If any dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever arises between the EMPLOYER/OWNER and the CONTRACTOR in connection with or arising out of this Contract, or carrying out of the works, it shall first be referred to and settled by the ISCOF-Office of the President, However, if the decision of the SUC President II is not satisfactory either to the EMPLOYER/OWNER or the CONTRACTOR, such dispute may be submitted to, and settled by the Office of the Campus Administrator. In case the decision is not be acceptable to the Contractor, the same shall be

elevated to the Construction Industry Arbitration Commission (CIAC) created by the Executive Order No. 1088 for settlement;

- 14. This contract/agreement becomes binding and valid upon the parties and shall remain effective upon approval hereof until the final completion and acceptance of the project;
- 15. The Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184, P.D. 1759, other existing laws, decrees, executive and administrative order, department orders/circulars issued by proper authorities affecting government construction projects, as well as the guidelines for the completion and payment of price escalation on infrastructure contracts adopted and approved by the Government, shall be made and formed as integral part of this contract;
- 16. The CONTRACTOR shall comply with, and strictly observe, all laws regarding workmen's health & safety, workmen's welfare, compensation for injuries, minimum wages, hours of labor and other labor laws as per relevant and applicable provisions of P.D. 442, as amended otherwise known as the Labor Code Law of the Philippines
